As you are aware, we are preparing to hear the government's 'road map' for the next phase in combating the Coronavirus, which is scheduled to be the topic for the Downing Street briefing on Sunday evening. This includes a review of the current social restrictions and we fully expect this to also include a statement regarding what will happen next with schools. There is increasing media coverage and discussion regarding when and how schools will open more widely. We have no advance warning about what the Prime Minister will announce, and will hear this information at the same time as the rest of the nation on Sunday evening. Therefore, to ensure that we have time to develop a strategic approach that supports the well-being of all stakeholders, we would ask you to be patient whilst we formulate an appropriate response to Sunday night's announcement. We will not be in a position to answer your questions immediately. Please be assured that the safety of our children, parents and staff remain at the heart of all decisions we take and we will continue to follow Department for Education and Public Health England advice. We will be in contact once we have processed whatever decision is taken, received specific further guidance from the government, and have put a plan in place. Thank you for your continued support during these challenging times.

We had hoped to be celebrating VE Day with you. Today we have had a very small number of pupils in school and they have been decorating Union Jack Flags and thinking about the 75th anniversary of VE Day. 'We'll meet again' always was a special song, but it has taken on a whole new meaning for us all.
